

study in Naples

Naples is one of the most populous city in Italy with a population of more than 3 million residents in its metropolitan area.

Founded by Greeks in the first millennium BC, the city is one of the oldest continuously inhabited urban areas in the world. Naples' historic city centre is the largest of its kind in Europe and has been designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

A wide range of culturally and historically significant sites are nearby, including the Palace of Caserta and the Roman ruins of Pompeii and Herculaneum. Naples is also known for its natural beauties, such as Posillipo, Phlegraean Fields, Nisida, and Vesuvius. Neapolitan cuisine is well known for its association with pizza, which originated in the city, as well as numerous other local dishes. The skyline of Naples is dominated by Centro Direzionale, the first cluster of skyscrapers built in Italy dating 1994, and the only one until 2009.

University of Naples Federico II was founded by Frederick II Hohenstaufen, King of Sicily and Head of the Roman Empire, on June 5th, 1224. The king's objective was to create an institution of higher learning free from the strong influence of the Pope. Nowadays, the University still carries on with passion and dedication the ancient educational project. The institution is nowadays made up of 26 Departments and it offers more than 150 Courses. The University has more than 300 international agreements with prestigious Universities, so both staff and students take part in a variety of exchange programmes, within Europe, and all over the world. The main objective is to create a network of students and teachers from laboratories and institutes of excellence, promoting inter-institutional research and collaboration, while maintaining excellence in all the fields of education and research. Such educational network is being geared towards the establishment of life-long, high level professional training programmes, both within Italy and the rest of the world.

the DBE course aims at building a creative and technical approach in line with the products and services market conditions, enterprise culture and aware of innovative processes.



To apply students must have obtained a bachelor degree or first degree or undergraduate degree, usually a three or four years course of at least 180 ECTS, in one of the following fields of study:

**Industrial
Design,
Architecture,
Engineering,
Fine Arts.**

**All courses are
held in English.**

Student must have a minimum B2 level in English.

If students don't have a language certification yet, their English knowledge will be tested on site by a departmental committee through an interview.
